

Installation Notes:
- Adjust Shelving is made for indoor use only.

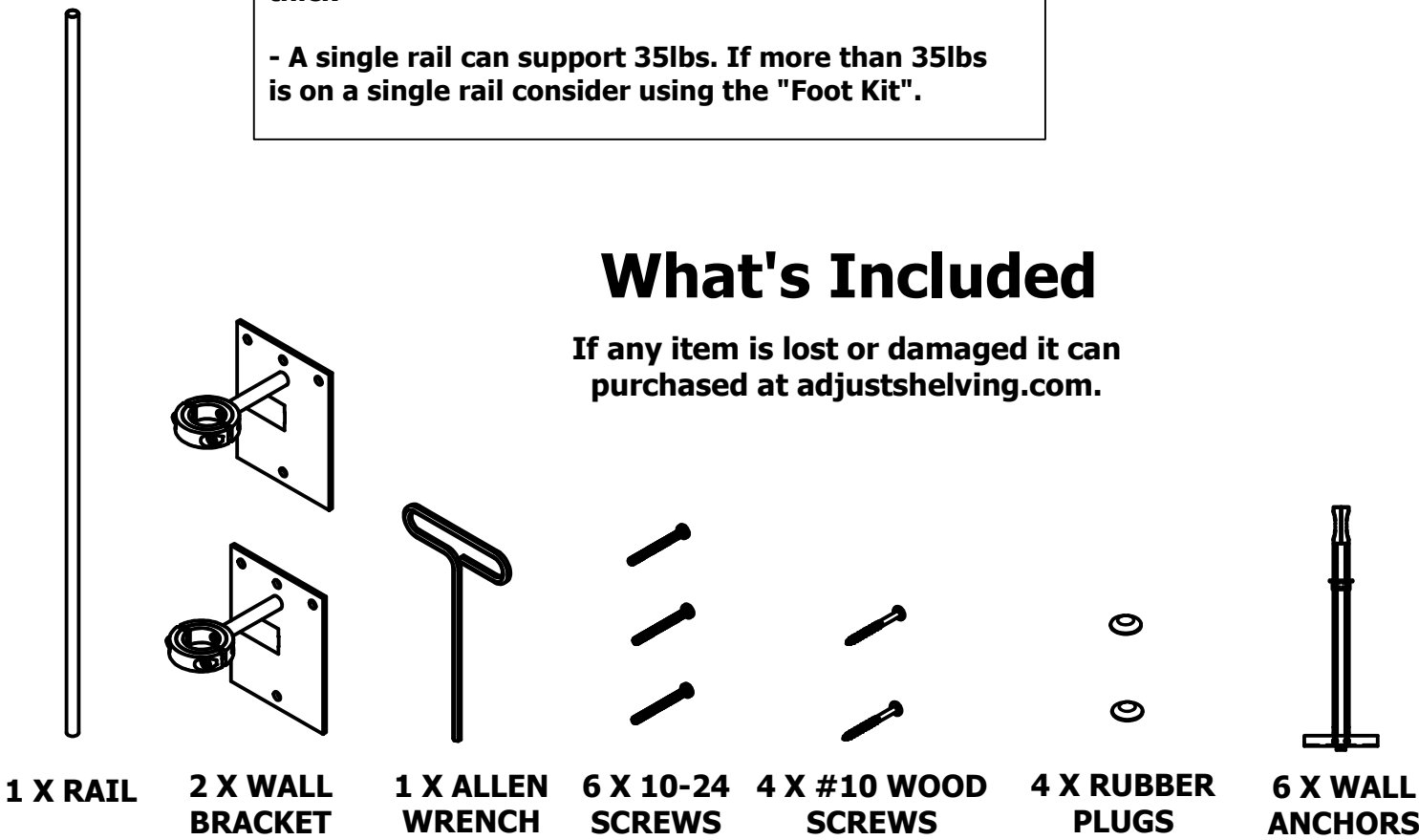
- Mounting to a stud whenever possible is the best way to secure Adjust Shelving to the wall.

- If supporting Adjust Shelving on to the wall without a stud then the following apply:
* The wall board must be in good condition without water damage, or cracking.
* At least 1/2" drywall is required
* Shiplap or paneled walls must be at least 3/8" thick

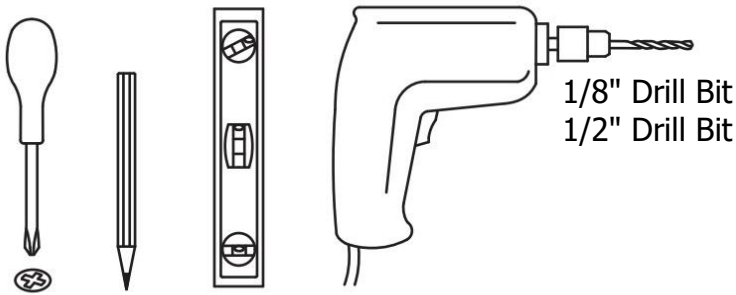
- A single rail can support 35lbs. If more than 35lbs is on a single rail consider using the "Foot Kit".

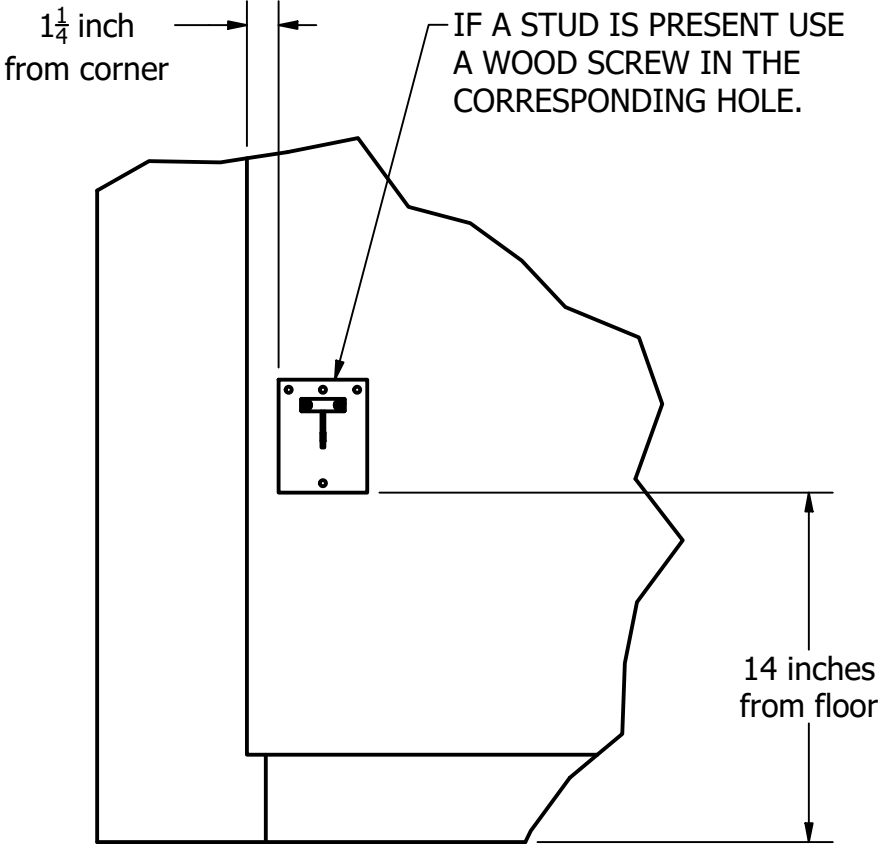

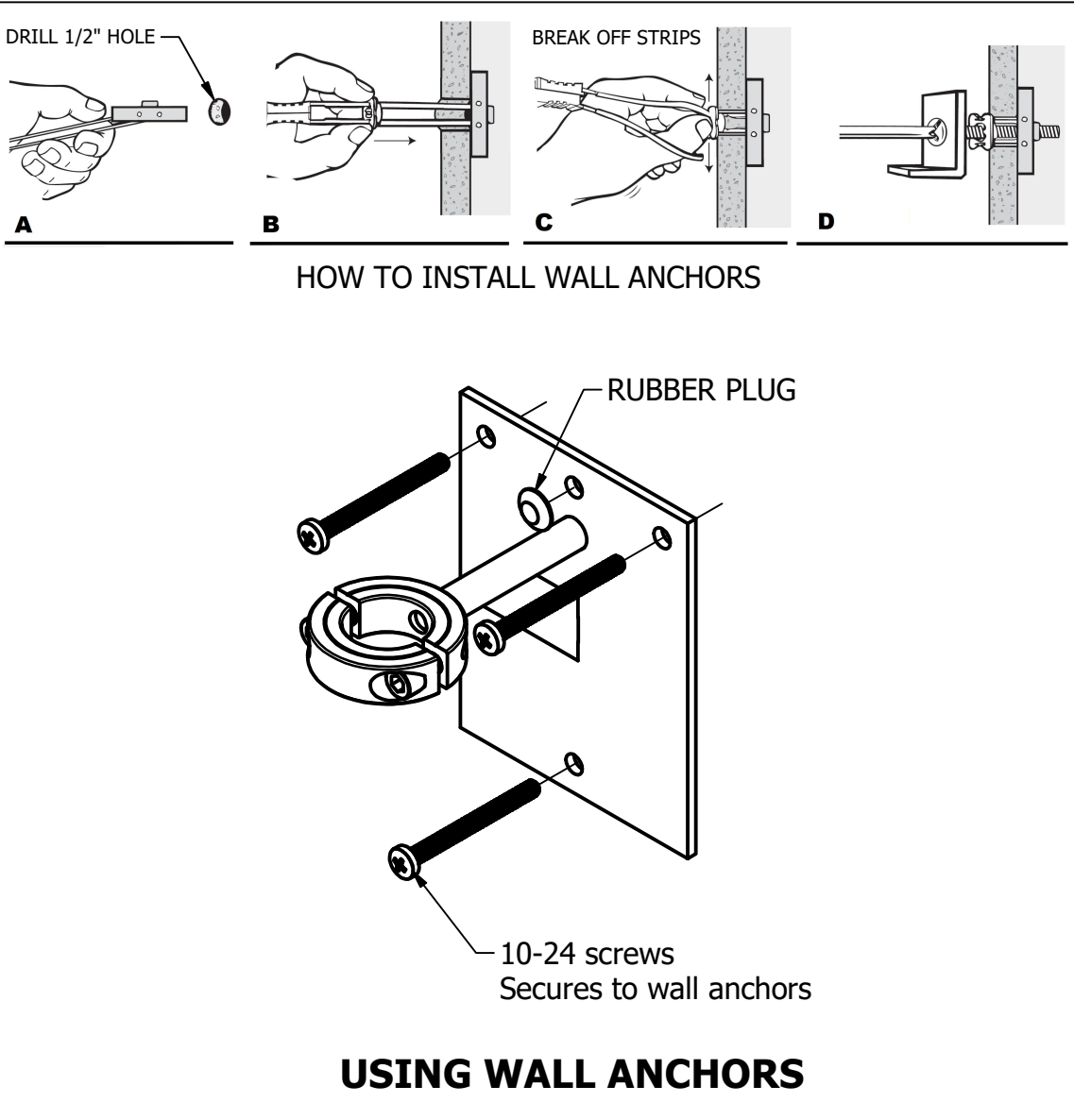
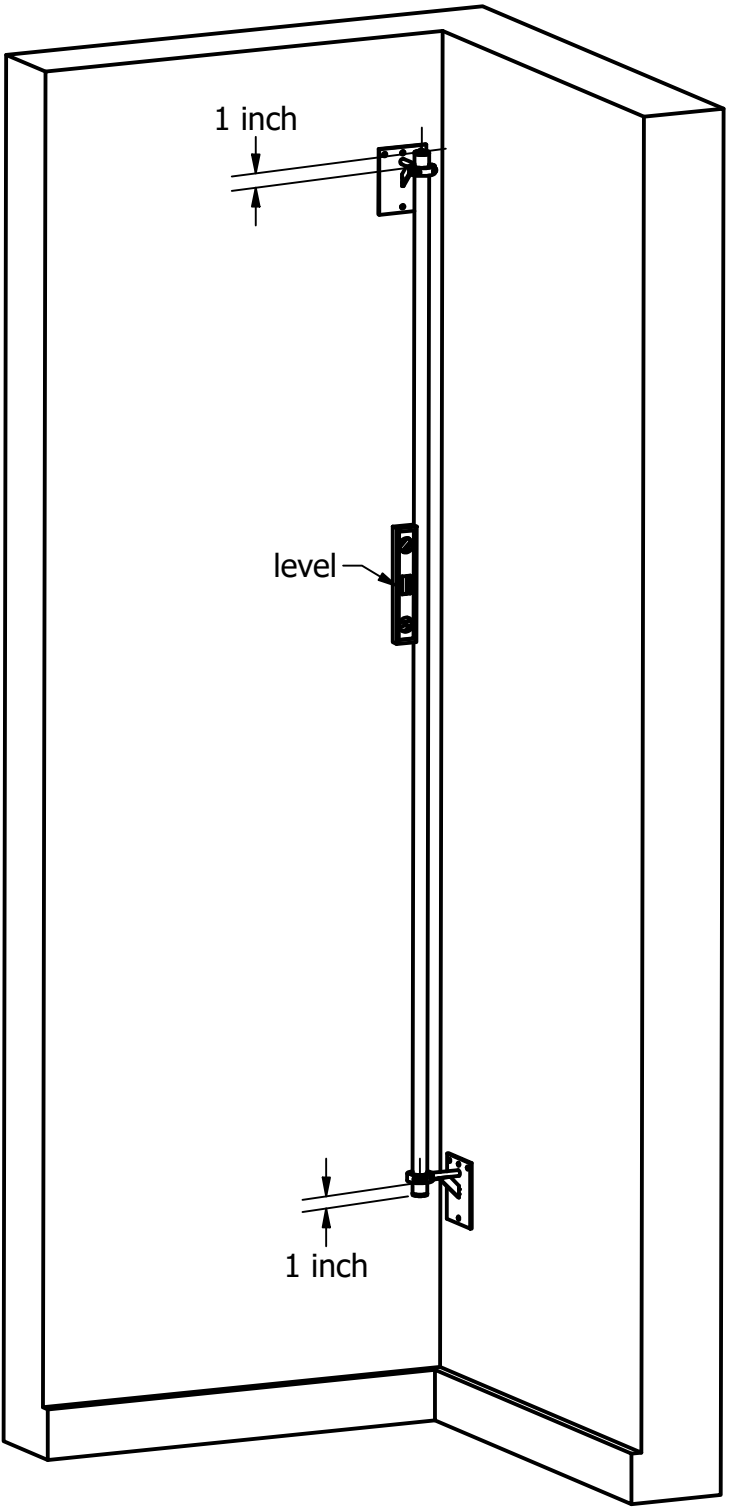
